
In re Complaint of John Doe<sup>1</sup>

This is a judicial complaint filed by an inmate (“complainant”) against a United States district judge. The judicial complaint alleges that the district judge “is becoming more political, and is showing much contempt for the Judicial Process.” In support of the complaint, complainant refers to language contained in orders entered by the district judge in two separate proceedings.

After thorough review, I conclude that the allegations are directly related to the merits of a decision . 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii); *accord* J.C.U.S. Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed.
