PER CURIAM.

Andre R. Crawford raises a variety of contentions related to the district court's dismissal of Crawford's employment-related lawsuit for failure to state a claim. Having reviewed the record in the context of Crawford's contentions, we conclude that no error of law appears in the district court's rulings and that an extended discussion is unnecessary. We decline to consider the arguments Crawford raises for the first time in his reply brief.
