PER CURIAM.

Aidrian Tokuhoshi filed suit against Tension Envelope Corporation (Tension) on September 18, 1997, alleging that Tension failed to promote him because of his national origin in violation of Title VII, 42 U.S.C. § 1981 and the Iowa Civil Rights Act and that Tension created a hostile work environment under Title VII. The district court¹ granted summary judgment in favor of Tension. Tokuhoshi appeals only as to the dismissal of his claim of a hostile work environment. After carefully reviewing the
