PER CURIAM.

Arkansas inmate Michael Jackson appeals from the district court's<sup>1</sup> 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1) dismissal without prejudice of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint. Having carefully reviewed the record and appellant's brief, we agree that the complaint failed to allege sufficient facts to state a claim. See Cooper v. Schriro, 189 F.3d 781, 783
