Stanford, an African American male, appeals from the district court's¹ grant of summary judgment to defendants in his action under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17, and § 301 of the National Labor Management Relations Act, 29 U.S.C. § 185.
