PER CURIAM.

Charles Armstrong appeals the district court's¹ order dismissing his pro se civil rights complaint against multiple defendants. After careful review of the record, we

conclude that Mr. Armstrong's complaint was frivolous and failed to state a claim. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(i), (ii); Bray v. Alexandria Women's Health Clinic, 506 U.S. 263, 267-68 (1993); Neitzke v. Williams, 490 U.S. 319, 325 (1989); West v. Atkins, 487 U.S. 42, 48 (1988); Monell v. Dep't of Soc. Servs., 436 U.S. 658, 691-95 (1978). Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47A(a).
