PER CURIAM.

Gabriel Wanaka appeals the order of the District Court¹ granting the motion of defendant Child & Family Development Corporation for summary judgment and dismissing Wanaka's employment-discrimination case. For reversal, Wanaka argues that numerous issues of fact preclude summary judgment and that the District Court erred in determining otherwise.

Having carefully reviewed the briefs and record, we conclude that Wanaka's arguments lack merit and that the District Court was correct in granting summary judgment in favor of defendant and dismissing the case.
