PER CURIAM.

Walter Lee Anderson appeals the revocation of his federal supervised release and subsequent resentencing by the District Court¹ after testing positive for cocaine. Anderson's counsel has moved to withdraw and has filed a brief under Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), identifying six issues that "might arguably support" Anderson's appeal. Id. at 744.
