PER CURIAM.

Paul Culbreath appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his civil action against Carl Dwayne Plumlee. Having carefully reviewed the record, *see Madewell v. Downs*, 68 F.3d 1030, 1036 (8th Cir. 1995) (de novo standard of review), we agree with the district court that Culbreath's allegations were either time-barred or meritless, for the reasons explained in the district court's opinion.
