PER CURIAM.

Ty Albert Van Tran pleaded guilty to conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (ice), in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(A), and 846. The district court¹ sentenced Tran to 168 months in prison and 5 years of supervised release. On appeal, Tran's counsel has moved to withdraw and filed a brief under Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Having reviewed the record independently pursuant to Penson v. Ohio, 488 U.S. 75

(1988), for any nonfrivolous issues, we find none. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment, and we grant counsel's motion to withdraw.
