PER CURIAM.

Arkansas state prisoner Roy Hoggard appeals following the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment and its denial of several post-judgment motions in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Having carefully reviewed the record, we conclude dismissal of the complaint was proper for the reasons explained by the district court.
