PER CURIAM.

Former Missouri prisoner Clifford Kallbah appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action, in which he claimed that Correctional Medical Services physicians were deliberately indifferent to his serious
