PER CURIAM.

Rebecca Shriver appeals the sentence the district court¹ imposed after she pleaded guilty to distributing methamphetamine, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C). Her counsel has moved to withdraw and filed a brief under Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967).

Shriver's plea agreement contains a valid appeal waiver. See United States v. Andis, 333 F.3d 886, 889-92 (8th Cir. 2003) (en banc) (discussing enforceability of

appeal waiver); see also United States v. Estrada-Bahena, 201 F.3d 1070, 1071 (8th Cir. 2000) (per curiam) (enforcing appeal waiver in Anders case). Having reviewed the record independently pursuant to Penson v. Ohio, 488 U.S. 75, 80 (1988), for any nonfrivolous issues not covered by the appeal waiver, we find none. Accordingly, we enforce the waiver and dismiss the appeal. We also grant counsel leave to withdraw.
