PER CURIAM.

Donald Wayne Duncan appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) dismissal of his lawsuit against the United States. To the extent Duncan's brief--which simply restates most of his claims and allegations--is sufficient to raise any issues for review, see Harris v. Folk Constr. Co., 138 F.3d 365, 366-67 n.1 (8th Cir. 1998) (by failing to assert grounds for challenging certain rulings, appellant is deemed to have waived related issues on appeal), we find no basis for reversal, see Moore v.
