Richard J. Wollenberg, III, appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his Title VII discrimination action. After reviewing the record de novo, viewing the evidence and all reasonable inferences from it in a light most favorable to Wollenberg, see Jacob-Mua v.
