PER CURIAM.

Iowa inmate James Cuellar appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) pre-service dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging that he and other inmates have been subjected to unconstitutional conditions and treatment at the Mount Pleasant Correctional Facility. After careful de novo review, *see Cooper v. Schriro*, 189 F.3d 781, 783 (8th Cir. 1999) (per curiam), we find no basis for reversal. Accordingly, the judgment is affirmed. *See* 8th Cir. R. 47B.
