PER CURIAM.

Barbara Kehr appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in her disability-discrimination action. After careful de novo review, *see Murphy v. Mo. Dep't of Corr.*, 372 F.3d 979, 982 (8th Cir. 2004), this court affirms. Kehr was not a qualified individual because she admitted she could not perform the essential functions of her job, *see Wisbey v. City of Lincoln, Neb.*, 612 F.3d 667, 672-73 (8th

Cir. 2010). Kehr's pretext argument fails because she failed to present a prima facie case of discrimination.
