PER CURIAM.

Arkansas inmate Phillip Oakes appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action for damages, asserting a claim of deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs. After careful de novo review, *see Sutherland v. Mo. Dep't of Corr.*, 580 F.3d 748, 750 (8th Cir. 2009) (standard of review), we find no basis for reversal, and accordingly we affirm, *see* 8th Cir. R. 47B.
