PER CURIAM.

Kevin Herring appeals the district court's¹ order revoking his supervised release and imposing a 10-month sentence. His counsel has moved for leave to

withdraw and has filed a brief questioning the reasonableness of Herring's revocation sentence.

Our review of the record satisfies us that the district court did not abuse its discretion in sentencing Herring as it did. <u>See United States v. Johnson</u>, 827 F.3d 740, 744 (8th Cir. 2016) (appellate court reviews district court's revocation sentence under abuse-of-discretion standard).

The judgment is affirmed, and counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is granted.
