



future crimes by Stanton. He also contends the restrictions jeopardize his contemplated photographic enterprise. We reject Stanton's contentions. The district court did not abuse its discretion in modifying Stanton's conditions of release. In our view, the restrictions Stanton challenges are reasonably related to the nature and circumstances of his offense and his history and characteristics. We thus affirm the district court's order modifying Stanton's conditions of supervised release. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
