PER CURIAM.

Louise N. Gordon appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> grant of summary judgment for the defendants in this diversity action for attorney malpractice and related claims. The district court held that Gordon is collaterally estopped from relitigating issues previously decided in a Minnesota state court proceeding awarding an attorneys' lien against her. Having reviewed the record and the parties' briefs, we conclude that the district court did not err in
