



Arkansas, police department, violated his Fourth and Fourteenth Amendment rights by stopping and arresting him without probable cause. Having reviewed the parties' submissions on appeal, we conclude that the district court did not err in denying qualified immunity on the facts of this case. Accordingly, we affirm the judgment entered on the verdict. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
