PER CURIAM.

Jorge Alcantara-Torres challenges the 75-month sentence imposed by the district court¹ after he pleaded guilty to a drug offense. He argues that the district court erred in not sentencing him at the lower end of the applicable Guidelines sentencing range. This court, however, has no jurisdiction to review this sentence within the Guidelines range. See 18 U.S.C. § 3742(a); United States v. Woodrum, 959 F.2d 100, 101 (8th Cir. 1992) (per curiam).

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
