PER CURIAM.

John T. Maclin appeals the district court's¹ order granting summary judgment affirming the Commissioner's decision to deny Maclin disability insurance benefits (DIB) and supplemental security income (SSI). After a careful review of the record and the parties' submissions we conclude substantial evidence on the record as a whole

supports the ALJ's conclusion that Maclin was engaged in substantial gainful activity during the period for which he seeks benefits, and thus was ineligible for DIB or SSI. Accordingly, we affirm the judgment of the district court. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
