PER CURIAM.

Michael Dean Warren pleaded guilty to being a felon in possession of a firearm. On appeal, Warren contends the district court improperly rejected his request for a downward departure. Warren also complains the government failed to comply with the plea agreement. We reject Warren's arguments. After a careful review of the record, we conclude the district court correctly resolved Warren's claims, and an opinion by this court would have no precedential value.
