PER CURIAM.

Kevin Vetter appeals from the district court's<sup>1</sup> grant of summary judgment to the United States and its dismissal with prejudice of his counterclaims and third-party cross-claims, as well as from its denial of his postjudgment motion to reconsider, in this action by the United States to recover unearned deficiency payments and interest from him.
