PER CURIAM.

Michael R. Williams, a Missouri inmate, appeals the district court's¹ 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Williams brought claims against the defendants alleging deliberate indifference to medical needs. Upon a careful review of the record and Williams's brief, we conclude that the district court's decision was correct. We deny all of Williams's pending motions.

Accordingly, the judgment of the district court is affirmed. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
