deny Oscar child's Supplemental Security Income. After carefully reviewing the record and the parties' submissions, we conclude that substantial evidence on the record as a whole supports the Commissioner's decision. Accordingly, we affirm the judgment of the district court. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
