PER CURIAM.

Maryann B. Posl appeals the district court's grant of summary judgment upholding the Commissioner's decision to deny Posl disability insurance and supplemental security income benefits. After careful review of the administrative record and the parties' briefs, we conclude substantial evidence supports the decision of the Commissioner that Posl is not disabled for Social Security purposes and the judgment of the district court is correct. This case presents no novel issues to justify an extended
