PER CURIAM.

Virgil O. Hooker, Dora E. Hooker, David O. Hooker, and Gloria J. Hooker sued an Arkansas state judge, alleging he had violated their constitutional rights by making certain rulings in a prior foreclosure action brought against the Hookers. The district

court¹ granted, on the basis of absolute judicial immunity, defendant's motion to dismiss, and denied the Hookers' postjudgment motions. Having carefully reviewed the record, we conclude the district court's rulings were clearly correct. Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47A(a).
