
PER CURIAM.

Roger Onstad, a South Dakota inmate, appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 conditions-of-confinement lawsuit. After careful review of the record and the parties' briefs, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. We also conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion by denying Onstad's motions for recusal, for appointed counsel, and to amend his complaint. Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
