PER CURIAM.

Kenneth Hunt appeals from the judgment entered by the district court¹ in favor of defendants after a bench trial on his discrimination claims brought under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e-2000e-17, and 42 U.S.C. § 1981.
