PER CURIAM.

Carole Johnson appeals the judgment of the District Court,¹ which sustained the final decision of the Commissioner to deny Johnson's claim for disability insurance benefits and supplemental security income.

Having carefully considered Johnson's appeal, we conclude that no error of law appears and that the Commissioner's decision that Johnson was not disabled within the meaning of the Social Security Act is supported by substantial evidence on the record as a whole.
