PER CURIAM.

Danny Corbishley appeals the district court's grant of summary judgment affirming the Commissioner's decision to deny Corbishley disability insurance benefits. Having reviewed the record and the parties' briefs, we conclude that no error of law or fact appears and that an extended opinion would serve no useful purpose in this fact-intensive case. We find substantial evidence supports the decision of the Commissioner, and Corbishley is not disabled for social security purposes. We thus affirm the district court without further discussion.
