Ricky Curry appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> order dismissing without prejudice his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action against various prison officials for failure to exhaust his

administrative remedies. After carefully reviewing the record, we conclude that Curry did not exhaust available prison remedies and therefore the district court's dismissal was consistent with 42 U.S.C. § 1997e(a). Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47A(a).
