PER CURIAM.

Harold and Janice Knight appeal the district court's¹ order dismissing their action seeking to recover for personal injuries sustained in an automobile accident because defendants allegedly conspired to harm and intimidate the Knights due to their public opposition to the Iran-Contra affair and alleged CIA involvement in drug trafficking. Having carefully reviewed the record, we conclude the district court properly dismissed

the complaint because the Knights failed to prove their allegation of federal diversity jurisdiction. Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
